

Qualification Criteria for ICFR Membership

1. Family Members means immediate family members, ie mothers, fathers, brothers, sisters, sons, daughters and grandchildren.
2. “Family members of Rotarians and Members, Rotary programme participants, and Rotary alumni.”
 - a. Family Members of a Rotarian (ie a member of a Rotary Club)
 - b. Family Members of ICFR Member (ie ICFR Member who is not a Rotarian.
 - c. If an Associate Member of ICFR it would be expected that they would have been an active Member of ICFR for at least 12 months and been involved in rallies.}
 - d. Rotary programme participants, and Rotary alumni. ie
 - Interact
 - Rotaract
 - Rotary Youth Exchange
 - New Generations Service Exchange
 - Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA)
 - Rotary Peace Fellowships
 - Rotary Scholarships (funded by global grants and district grants)
 - Vocational training teams (members and leaders)
 - Ambassadorial Scholarships
 - Grants for University Teachers
 - Group Study Exchange (members and leaders)
 - Rotary Volunteers
 - Past Rotarian who is not currently an ICFR Member
 - Widow(er) of a Rotarian

Membership is open on an international basis and applications will be accepted by the ICFR Executive, subject to interested and qualified applicants being of good standing and they, and their spouses, being willing and able to:

- correspond, co-operate and take part in ICFR activities
- Prove membership of a Rotary Club or other criteria allowed hereunder.
